

GUIDELINES for FREEMASONS as approved by the MW Grand Master
for REMEMBRANCE DAY

DRESS CODE :

Freemasons participating are required to wear a business suit.

MILITARY MEDALS :

1. If worn these must be FULL size (no miniatures).
2. Brethren who choose to wear military medals which have been officially awarded to them, are to wear them on the LEFT breast.
3. Medals of parents or grandparents, if worn, MUST be worn on the RIGHT breast.

MASONIC REGALIA :

1. If a Brother wears military medals, he MUST NOT wear Masonic breast jewels.
2. Masonic breast jewels may be worn PROVIDED military medals are NOT worn.
3. The standard square and compass lapel pin is acceptable. No other Masonic pins are to be worn.
4. Aprons and collars MUST be clean and suitable for public view, otherwise are not to be worn.
5. Masonic collarettes and neck jewels may be worn.

PROCEDURE :

1. Brethren should proceed from a place of initial assembly to the place of ceremony in orderly fashion.
2. After the ceremony Brethren are to immediately return to the assembly place and remove regalia. They are not to “hang around” wearing regalia.
3. Food, drinks and tobacco may not be consumed while wearing regalia.
